<ul> <li>16 (a) (1) [Each] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS</li> <li>17 SUBSECTION, EACH board of library trustees consists of seven members appointed by</li> <li>18 the county governing body from nominees submitted by the board of library trustees.</li> </ul>		
19(2)A board that existed before 1945 under a corporate charter may20continue as constituted if:		
21	(i)	It has at least seven members;
22 (ii) The members are chosen on the basis of character, ability, and 23 demonstrated interest in library matters; and		
24	(iii)	The members meet the qualifications required under subsection

25 (b) of this section.

(3) IN HARFORD COUNTY, THE PUBLIC LIBRARY BOARD OF TRUSTEES
 CONSISTS OF AT LEAST 7 MEMBERS BUT NOT MORE THAN 11 MEMBERS APPOINTED
 BY THE COUNTY GOVERNING BODY FROM NOMINEES SUBMITTED BY THE BOARD OF
 TRUSTEES.

5 (b) The members of the board shall be:

6 (1) Representative of the area the library serves; and

7 (2) Residents of the county that the library serves.

8 (c) (1) Except as provided in [subsection (d)] SUBSECTIONS (D) AND (E) of

9 this section, a member of a board serves for a term of 5 years and until a successor is

10 appointed and qualifies. These terms are staggered as required by the terms of the

11 members serving on the board as of July 1, 1978.

12 (2) Except as provided in paragraph (4) of this subsection, a member may 13 be reappointed but may not serve more than two consecutive terms.

14 (3) A member appointed to fill a vacancy in an unexpired term:

15 (i) Serves only for the remainder of that term and until a successor 16 is appointed and qualifies; and

17(ii)Is eligible for appointment to serve two additional consecutive18 terms.

19(4)A member of the board of the Prince George's County Memorial20Library System may serve an unlimited number of consecutive terms of office.

21 (d) In Charles County, a member of the board serves for a term of 4 years.

(e) IN HARFORD COUNTY, A MEMBER OF THE BOARD SERVES FOR A TERM OF
5 YEARS, BEGINNING ON JULY 1, AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND
QUALIFIES.

25 (F) Each member of a board serves without compensation.

26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 27 effect October 1, 2002.
