19 (A) A MANAGED CARE ORGANIZATION MAY DEEM A HEALTH CARE PROVIDER

20 CREDENTIALED FOR A PERIOD OF NOT MORE THAN 6 MONTHS FROM THE DATE OF

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

21 RECEIPT OF A COMPLETED APPLICATION IF:

- 1 (1) THE HEALTH CARE PROVIDER:
- 2 (I) HAS BEEN CREDENTIALED BY ANOTHER ENTITY IN THE STATE 3 THAT IS REQUIRED TO CREDENTIAL HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS; AND
- 4 (II) HAS SUBMITTED AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE
- 5 MANAGED CARE ORGANIZATION'S PROVIDER PANEL; AND
- 6 (2) THE MANAGED CARE ORGANIZATION VERIFIES THAT THE HEALTH
- 7 CARE PROVIDER WAS CREDENTIALED AND REMAINS IN GOOD STANDING WITH AT
- 8 LEAST ONE ENTITY THAT CREDENTIALED THE HEALTH CARE PROVIDER.
- 9 (B) AN ENTITY THAT HAS CREDENTIALED A HEALTH CARE PROVIDER MAY
- 10 NOT REFUSE TO PROVIDE INFORMATION TO A REQUEST BY A MANAGED CARE
- 11 ORGANIZATION THAT SEEKS VERIFICATION OF THE CREDENTIALED HEALTH CARE
- 12 PROVIDER TO VERIFY THAT THE HEALTH CARE PROVIDER IS CREDENTIALED AND IN
- 13 GOOD STANDING.
- 14 (C) NOTHING IN THIS SECTION MAY BE CONSTRUED TO RELIEVE THE
- 15 MANAGED CARE ORGANIZATION FROM FULLY CREDENTIALING ITS HEALTH CARE
- 16 PROVIDERS.
- 17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 18 October 1, 2002.
