- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing that in an action brought to recover damages for
- 4 negligence under certain circumstances, the fact that a plaintiff may have been
- 5 contributorily negligent shall not bar recovery by the plaintiff or plaintiff's legal
- 6 representative or beneficiary under certain circumstances; requiring any
- 7 damages awarded under this Act to be diminished in proportion to the amount of
- 8 negligence attributed to the plaintiff; providing for the application of this Act;
- 9 and generally relating to actions for damages and the Maryland Comparative

- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 19 Article Courts and Judicial Proceedings
- 20 SUBTITLE 2A. MARYLAND COMPARATIVE NEGLIGENCE ACT.
- 21 11-2A-01.
- 22 (A) IN AN ACTION BROUGHT TO RECOVER DAMAGES FOR NEGLIGENCE THAT
- 23 RESULTED IN THE DEATH OF AN INDIVIDUAL, INJURY TO A PERSON, OR DAMAGE TO
- 24 PROPERTY, THE FACT THAT THE PLAINTIFF MAY HAVE BEEN CONTRIBUTORILY
- 25 NEGLIGENT MAY NOT BAR A RECOVERY BY THE PLAINTIFF, OR THE PLAINTIFF'S
- 26 LEGAL REPRESENTATIVE OR BENEFICIARY, IF THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE PLAINTIFF
- 27 WAS LESS THAN THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE DEFENDANT OR THE COMBINED
- 28 NEGLIGENCE OF ALL DEFENDANTS AGAINST WHOM RECOVERY IS SOUGHT.

- 1 (B) THE DAMAGES AWARDED IN AN ACTION DESCRIBED IN THIS SECTION
- 2 SHALL BE DIMINISHED IN PROPORTION TO THE AMOUNT OF NEGLIGENCE
- 3 ATTRIBUTED TO THE PLAINTIFF.
- 4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be
- 5 construed to apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have
- 6 any effect on or application to any cause of action arising before the effective date of
- 7 this Act.
- 8 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 9 October 1, 2002.
