(B) ON RETIREMENT UNDER THIS SECTION, A MEMBER IS ENTITLED TO
RECEIVE AN EARLY SERVICE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE THAT EQUALS THE NORMAL
SERVICE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE UNDER § 27-402 OF THIS SUBTITLE, REDUCED BY
THE FRACTION CALCULATED IN § 27-402(C) OF THIS SUBTITLE AND MULTIPLIED BY
0.66% FOR EACH MONTH THAT THE MEMBER'S EARLY RETIREMENT DATE PRECEDES
THE DATE THE MEMBER WILL BE 60 YEARS OLD.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
