## 2 Education - High School Diplomas - World War II Veterans

- 3 FOR the purpose of allowing an individual honorably discharged from military
- 4 service to apply to certain county boards of education to obtain a high school
- 5 diploma if the individual withdrew from a certain full-time public or private
- 6 school in the individual's junior or senior year; making this Act an emergency
- 7 measure; and generally relating to high school diplomas.
- 8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 15 Article - Education

16 7-206.1.

- 17 (a) An individual honorably discharged from military service may apply to
- 18 obtain a high school diploma if the individual withdrew from a regular full-time
- 19 public or private school accredited by the State Board during the individual's JUNIOR
- 20 OR senior year in high school to enlist in the armed forces of the United States during
- 21 World War II.
- 22 (b) To obtain a high school diploma under subsection (a) of this section, the
- 23 individual shall apply to the county board in the county where the individual resides
- 24 or where the school from which the individual withdrew was located.

- 1 Each county board shall adopt rules and regulations to establish (c) 2 procedures for awarding diplomas under this section.
- 3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency 4 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety,
- 5 has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members
- 6 elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from
- 7 the date it is enacted.
