SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

1 A Senate Joint Resolution concerning

2 **Miller Senate Building - Cornerstone Inscriptions**

3 FOR the purpose of providing that the names of the current Governor, Treasurer, and  
4 Comptroller of Maryland be inscribed on the cornerstone of the Miller Senate  
5 Building.

6 WHEREAS, The cornerstone of the James Senate Office Building includes the  
7 names of the Governor, Treasurer, and Comptroller of Maryland in office at the time  
8 of the dedication of the building; and

9 WHEREAS, For posterity, the names of the current Governor, Treasurer, and  
10 Comptroller of Maryland ought to be inscribed on the cornerstone of the Miller Senate  
11 Building; now, therefore, be it

12 **RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND**, That the names  
13 of the Honorable Parris N. Glendening, Governor, the Honorable Richard N. Dixon,  
14 Treasurer, and the Honorable William Donald Schaefer, Comptroller be inscribed on  
15 the cornerstone of the Miller Senate Building; and be it further

16 **RESOLVED**, That a copy of this Resolution be forwarded by the Department of  
17 Legislative Services to the Honorable Parris N. Glendening, Governor of Maryland;  
18 the Honorable Thomas V. Mike Miller, Jr., President of the Senate of Maryland; and  
19 the Honorable Casper R. Taylor, Jr., Speaker of the House of Delegates.
