SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

1 A Senate Joint Resolution concerning

2 **Miller Senate Building - Cornerstone Inscriptions**

3 FOR the purpose of providing that the names of the ~~current~~ Governor, Treasurer, and
4 Comptroller of Maryland who were in office at the time of completion of the
5 Miller Senate Building be inscribed on the cornerstone of the Miller Senate
6 Building.

7 WHEREAS, The cornerstone of the James Senate Office Building includes the
8 names of the Governor, Treasurer, and Comptroller of Maryland in office at the time
9 of the dedication of the building; and

10 WHEREAS, For posterity, the names of the ~~current~~ Governor, Treasurer, and
11 Comptroller of Maryland who were in office at the time of completion of the Miller
12 Senate Building ought to be inscribed on the cornerstone of the Miller Senate
13 Building; now, therefore, be it

14 RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the names
15 of the Honorable Parris N. Glendening, Governor, the Honorable Richard N. Dixon,
16 Treasurer, and the Honorable William Donald Schaefer, Comptroller be inscribed on
17 the cornerstone of the Miller Senate Building; and be it further

18 RESOLVED, That a copy of this Resolution be forwarded by the Department of
19 Legislative Services to the Honorable Parris N. Glendening, Governor of Maryland;
20 the Honorable Thomas V. Mike Miller, Jr., President of the Senate of Maryland; and
21 the Honorable Casper R. Taylor, Jr., Speaker of the House of Delegates.
