FISCAL NOTE

House Bill 1030

(Cecil County Delegation)

Judicial Proceedings

Cecil County - Sheriff - Salary

This bill increases the salary of the Sheriff of Cecil County from \$47,000 to \$50,000 beginning with the next term of office in January 2003. The bill also specifies annual raises of \$1,500 in calendars 2004 and 2005, and a raise of \$1,000 in calendar 2006.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Cecil County expenditures would increase by \$1,950 in FY 2003 and by \$9,100 in FY 2007 and each year thereafter. Revenues would not be affected.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: The current salary of the Sheriff of Cecil County is \$47,000. Salary adjustments for constitutional officers take effect at the beginning of the next term of office which begins in January 2003 for the sheriff of Cecil County.

Background: The salary of the Sheriff of Cecil County was last increased in 1999 (Chapter 97 of 1997) when the salary was increased from \$42,000 to \$47,000.

Local Fiscal Effect: Cecil County expenditures would increase by \$1,950 in fiscal 2003 for additional salary (\$1,500) and fringe benefits (\$450). This reflects salary adjustments for a six-month period (January 2003 - June 2003). Future year expenditures would increase by \$4,875 in fiscal 2004, by \$6,825 in fiscal 2005, by \$8,450 in fiscal 2006, and by \$9,100 in fiscal 2007.
