**Department of General Services - Security Force - Transfers**

---

This bill permits a member of the Department of General Services (DGS) security force to be transferred involuntarily from one site to another.

The bill is effective June 1, 2002.

---

**Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** Increase in administrative efficiency for DGS in the location assignment of personnel. No impact on revenues.

**Local Effect:** None.

**Small Business Effect:** None.

**Analysis**

**State Fiscal Effect:** DGS advises that the bill's provisions would increase administrative efficiency by allowing the department to deploy personnel where they are needed most. As an example, DGS could shift security personnel in the Baltimore Detachment to the Annapolis Detachment during the legislative session. DGS advises that there are 48 security personnel in the Baltimore Detachment and 60 in the Annapolis Detachment.
