(Carroll County Delegation)

Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs

Carroll County - Board of Education - Start of Term

This bill requires that members elected to the Carroll County Board of Education begin their term on the first Monday in December following the election.

The bill is effective July 1, 2002.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Requiring an elected member of the Carroll County Board of Education to begin a term on the first Monday in December following an election would not affect county finances.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: The five members of the Carroll County Board of Education serve staggered terms. Each member serves a four-year term until a successor is elected and qualifies.

Background: Carroll County advises that members of the Board of Education begin their terms in the month of January immediately following a general election.
