**Prince George's County - Walker Mill Community Development Corporation  
Loan of 1996**

---

This bill changes the name of the Prince George's County – Walker Mill Gardens Community Outreach Center, Inc. Loan of 1996 to the Prince George's County – Walker Mill Community Development Corporation Loan of 1996. The bill changes: (1) the grantee to the Board of Directors of Walker Mill Community Development Corporation; and (2) the purpose to the repair and renovation of a wing of Walker Mill Baptist Church, located at 6801 Walker Mill Road in Capitol Heights, to be used: (1) as a facility for computer training programs, day care center, and before and after school child care facility; and (2) for special youth programs. The bill specifies that no portion of the proceeds of the loan or any of the matching funds may be used for the furtherance of sectarian religious instruction, or in connection with a building used or to be used as a place of sectarian religious worship or instruction.

The bill is effective June 1, 2002.

**Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** Changing the grantee and the purpose of the loan would not materially affect State finances.

**Local Effect:** None.

**Small Business Effect:** Minimal effect on one small nonprofit entity.

## Analysis

**Current Law:** Chapter 297 of 1996 authorized up to \$100,000 to the Board of Directors of the Walker Mill Gardens Community Outreach Center, Inc., as grantee, for the planning, design, repair, renovation, and capital equipping of four apartments at the Belle Haven Community Outreach Center, located in Landover, Maryland, to be used as a facility for computer training programs and as a day care center for children of the participants in the computer training programs.

**Background:** The location where the project was to have been located has since been slated for destruction. The project will be relocated to the Walker Mill Baptist Church. The grantee has changed its corporate name and expanded its corporate purpose.
