**Harford County Local Department of Social Services - Advisory Board -  
Membership**

This bill authorizes the expansion of the Harford County local department of social services advisory board from 9 members to no more than 13 members.

The bill is effective July 1, 2002.

**Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** None. Any increase in expense reimbursements for new members could be handled with existing resources.

**Local Effect:** None.

**Small Business Effect:** None.

**Analysis**

**Current Law:** Local boards of social services in Frederick, Garrett, and Montgomery counties may include up to 13 members. Other local boards consist of nine members each.

**State Expenditures:** Harford County local department of social services board members would be reimbursed for expenses under the standard State travel regulations. Any such expenditures would depend on the time, location, and frequency of the board's meetings, and could be handled with existing resources.
