### **Election Law - Local Regulation of Campaign Finance**

This bill authorizes counties to regulate campaign finance provided that any adopted provision be as stringent as and consistent with State campaign finance law.

### **Fiscal Summary**

State Effect: None.

**Local Effect:** Should a local government decide to regulate campaign finance pursuant to the bill, the significance of any increased expenditures would depend on the requirements of such regulation. It is anticipated, however, that most local provisions could be handled within existing resources.

**Small Business Effect:** None.

Current Law: Campaign finances are regulated by the State Board of Elections.
