Baltimore City - Local Social Services Board - Membership

This bill authorizes the expansion of the Baltimore City local department of social services board from nine members to no more than 13 members.

The bill takes effect July 1, 2002.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: Any increase in expense reimbursements for new members could be handled with existing resources.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: Local boards of social services in Frederick, Garrett and Montgomery counties may include up to 13 members. Other local boards consist of nine members each.

State Fiscal Effect: Baltimore City local department of social services board members would be reimbursed for expenses under the standard State travel regulations. Any such expenditures would depend upon the time, location, and frequency of the board's meetings, and could be handled with existing resources.
