Budget and Taxation Appropriations

Calvert County - Community Learning Center Loan of 2001

This bill alters the purpose of the Calvert County – Community Learning Center Loan of 2001 by: (1) authorizing the acquisition of property; and (2) changing the location of the project by repealing the reference to Duke Street.

The bill is effective June 1, 2002.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. Authorizing the use of funds by the acquisition of property and changing the location of the project would not materially affect State finances.

Local Effect: Minimal effect on Calvert County.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: Chapter 405 of 2001 authorized up to \$400,000 in matching funds to the Board of County Commissioners of Calvert County, as grantee, for the for the planning, design, and construction of a community learning center on Duke Street in Prince Frederick, Maryland.

Background: The grantee had intended to use the project to upgrade the current Prince Frederick Library facility. The grantee now intends to build a new facility. The grantee

has identified two possible locations within the town center. The grantee already has funding sufficient to meet the required match.
