Appropriations

Prince George's County - Riversdale Mansion Loan of 2000

This bill extends the deadline, from June 1, 2002 to June 1, 2004, for the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission, as grantee, to provide matching funds for the Prince George's County – Riverside Mansion Loan of 2000.

The bill is effective June 1, 2002.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. Extending the deadline for the provision of matching funds would not materially affect State finances.

Local Effect: Minimal effect on the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: Chapter 605 of 2000 authorized up to \$300,000 in matching funds for the construction, reconstruction, repair, renovation, and capital equipping of the Riversdale Mansion and surrounding property, including construction of an octagonal barn. The fund may consist of real property; however, the fund may not include in kind contributions or funds expended prior to June 1, 2000.

Background: The grantee has designated funding sufficient to meet the required match and is in the process of having its match certified.
