House Bill 954 Ways and Means (Prince George's County Delegation)

Prince George's County - Public Schools - Moment of Silence PG 419-02

This bill requires all public elementary and secondary school students in Prince George's County to observe one minute of silence each morning of a school day.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: None. Providing one minute of silence each school morning would not affect Prince George's County finances.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: Principals and teachers in public elementary and secondary schools may require all students to be present and participate in daily opening exercises and to meditate silently for approximately one minute.

Additional Information

Prior Introductions: A similar bill that applied to all local school systems was introduced last year as HB 1156. The bill received an unfavorable report from the House Ways and Means Committee.
