Calvert County - Extension of Task Force to Study the Infrastructure Needs of Private Communities in Calvert County

This bill extends the termination provision of the Task Force to Study the Infrastructure Needs of Private Communities in Calvert County from December 31, 2002 to December 31, 2003.

The bill is effective June 1, 2002.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Calvert County expenditures could increase to the extent that county staff selected to support the study are required to work overtime. Any additional costs are assumed to be minimal.

Current Law: The termination date of the Task Force to Study the Infrastructure Needs of Private Communities in Calvert County is December 31, 2002.

Background: The Task Force to Study the Infrastructure Needs of Private Communities in Calvert County was established by Chapter 544 of 2001 (HB 1222). The task force is

charged with conducting a comprehensive survey of the infrastructure needs of private communities in Calvert County and delivering a final report to the Calvert County Delegation to the Maryland General Assembly no later than December 31, 2002.
