Cecil County - The Boys and Girls Clubs of Cecil County, Inc. Loan of 2000

---

This bill extends the deadline, from June 1, 2002 to June 1, 2004, for the Board of Directors of The Boys and Girls Clubs of Cecil County, Inc., as grantee, to provide matching funds for the Cecil County – The Boys and Girls Clubs of Cecil County, Inc. Loan of 2000.

The bill is effective June 1, 2002.

Fiscal Summary

**State Effect:** None. Extending the deadline for the provision of matching funds would not materially affect State finances.

**Local Effect:** None.

**Small Business Effect:** Minimal effect on one small nonprofit entity.

Analysis

**Current Law:** Chapter 696 of 2000 authorized up to \$100,000 in matching funds for the acquisition, planning, design, and capital equipping of a site in Cecil County to house a Boys and Girls Club.

**Background:** To date, the grantee has raised approximately \$7,500 toward the required match. The matching funds may consist of real property, in kind contributions, or funds expended prior to the loan's effective date. The grantee is currently in discussions with

potential donors for donations of real property and cash. The grantee anticipates receiving the remainder of the required match by the end of calendar 2002.
