#### **Uniformed State Employees**

This bill permits uniformed State employees to attach, a symbol of the United States flag to the employee's uniform. The bill also provides that nothing in the State Personnel and Pensions Article or corresponding regulations may be construed to prohibit a uniformed State employee from attaching a symbol of the United States flag to the employee's uniform. State agencies that employ uniformed employees must establish guidelines for wearing the symbol of the U.S. flag, which may include the size, location, and form of the symbol.
