### Police Training Commission - Membership - Maryland Municipal League Police Executive Association

This bill adds the Chairman of the Maryland Municipal League Police Executive Association to the list of members of the Police Training Commission.

# **Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** Any expense reimbursements for the new commission member are assumed to be minimal and absorbable within existing budgeted resources of the Police Training Commission.

### **Analysis**

Current Law: The Police Training Commission is a statutory agency within the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services. Its membership consists of the following persons: The President of the Maryland Chiefs of Police Association; the President of the Maryland Sheriffs Association; the President of the Maryland Law Enforcement Officers, Inc.; the Attorney General of Maryland; the Secretary of the State Police; the Commissioner of the Baltimore City Police Department; the Chancellor of the University System of Maryland; the agent in charge of the Baltimore office of the F.B.I.; the President of the Eastern Shore Police Association; a representative of the Maryland State Lodge of Fraternal Order of Police; the Deputy Secretary of Public Safety and Correctional Services; and three police officials.

**Background:** Subject to the authority of the Secretary of Public Safety and Correctional Services, the Maryland Police Training Commission is vested with the authority to set standards of initial selection and training for police officers in the State of Maryland, and to conduct and operate approved police training schools.

The Police Executives Association is one of seven affiliate professional organizations within the Maryland Municipal League, known as departments, created by the board of directors to facilitate communication and cooperation within the league and between municipalities and levels of state and local government.
