#### State Highways - Designation - Korean War Veterans Memorial Highway

This bill requires the State Highway Administration (SHA) to designate the Frederick County portion of Interstate Highway 70 as the Korean War Veterans Memorial Highway.

### **Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** Minimal. The SHA estimates that it would need to erect two signs at the cost of \$1,000 each. These costs could be handled with existing resources. Revenues would not be affected.

Local Effect: None.

**Small Business Effect:** None.

#### **Analysis**

**Current Law:** Chapter 180 of 2001 designates Maryland Route 43 as the Korean War Veterans Memorial Highway.

**Background:** Approximately 77,000 Maryland citizens served in the Korean Conflict from 1950 to 1953; 518 of the U.S. military personnel who were killed or captured were from Maryland.
