Finance

State Highways - Designation - Korean War Veterans Memorial Highway

This bill requires the State Highway Administration (SHA) to designate the Frederick County portion of Interstate Highway 70 as the Korean War Veterans Memorial Highway.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: Minimal. The SHA estimates that it would need to erect two signs at the cost of \$1,000 each. These costs could be handled with existing resources. Revenues would not be affected.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: Chapter 180 of 2001 designates Maryland Route 43 as the Korean War Veterans Memorial Highway.

Background: Approximately 77,000 Maryland citizens served in the Korean Conflict from 1950 to 1953; 518 of the U.S. military personnel who were killed or captured were from Maryland.
