University System of Maryland - Board of Regents

This bill adds the State Treasurer as a nonvoting ex officio member to the Board of Regents of the University System of Maryland.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: Any additional costs associated with expense reimbursements for the Board of Regents could be handled with existing resources.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: The University System of Maryland Board of Regents consists of 17 members: the Secretary of Agriculture, 1 student member, and 15 members from the general public. All members have full voting rights. The Secretary of Agriculture is an ex officio member, and the other 16 members are appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the State Senate. The student member serves a one-year term, and the other appointed members serve five-year terms. With the exception of the Secretary of Agriculture, members are limited to two consecutive full terms. Members serve without compensation but are entitled to expense reimbursements.
