House Joint Resolution 38 (Delegate Mohorovic)
Commerce and Government Matters

Coal Miners - Commemorative Stamp

This joint resolution urges the United States Postal Service to honor and pay tribute to the past and present coal miners of this nation by issuing a commemorative postal stamp in their honor.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. Compliance with this joint resolution would not directly affect State finances.

Analysis

Current Law: On behalf of the Postmaster General, a 15-member Citizen's Stamp Advisory Committee recommends the subject of postage stamps. The Postmaster General appoints members of the committee, which was established in 1957. The committee's primary goal is to select subjects for recommendation to the Postmaster General that are both interesting and educational. Approximately 25 new subjects for commemorative stamps are recommended each year.
