#### Prince George's County - Mt. Rainier Revitalization Project Loan of 2000

This bill extends the deadline, from June 1, 2002 to June 1, 2004, for the Board of Directors of the Housing Initiative Partnership, Inc., as grantee, to provide matching funds for the Prince George's County – Mt. Rainier Revitalization Project Loan of 2000.

The bill is effective June 1, 2002.

## **Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** None. Extending the deadline for the provision of matching funds would not materially affect State finances.

Local Effect: None.

**Small Business Effect:** Minimal effect on one small nonprofit entity.

### **Analysis**

**Current Law:** Chapter 695 of 2000 authorized up to \$60,000 in matching funds for the planning, design, repair, renovation, reconstruction, and capital equipping, including any applicable architects' and engineers' fees, of an apartment building in Mt. Rainier, Maryland, for residences for low-income artists. No part of the funds may consist of real property, in kind contributions, or funds expended prior to June 1, 2000.

**Background:** The grantee currently has funds sufficient to meet the required match but has not begun the certification process.
