AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 520

(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 7, after “circumstances;” insert “requiring public institutions of higher education and community colleges that admit certain students to keep a record of the number of individuals paying resident tuition charges as a result of certain qualifications and to report certain information to the Maryland Higher Education Commission; requiring the Commission to submit a certain report to the General Assembly each year;”; and strike beginning with “Maryland” in line 7 down through “Education” in line 8.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 26, after “(C)” insert “(1) A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION OR A COMMUNITY COLLEGE THAT ADMITS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO QUALIFIES FOR RESIDENT TUITION CHARGES UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL:”

(I) KEEP A RECORD OF THE NUMBER OF INDIVIDUALS WHO PAY RESIDENT TUITION CHARGES AS A RESULT OF QUALIFICATION UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION; AND

(II) REPORT THE INFORMATION REQUIRED IN ITEM (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH TO THE COMMISSION EACH YEAR.

(2) THE COMMISSION SHALL SUBMIT TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2-1246 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, A REPORT CONSISTING OF A COMPILATION OF THE REPORTS SUBMITTED TO THE COMMISSION UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION.
