AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 680

(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

At the top of page 1, insert "EMERGENCY BILL"; in line 4, after "from" insert "certain"; in line 7, strike "under" and substitute "in a certain year under"; and strike beginning with "requiring" in line 7 down through "regulations" in line 8 and substitute "making this Act an emergency measure".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 3, after "(a)" insert "(1) AN INDIVIDUAL HONORABLY DISCHARGED FROM MILITARY SERVICE MAY APPLY TO OBTAIN A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA IF THE INDIVIDUAL WITHDREW FROM A REGULAR FULL-TIME PUBLIC OR PRIVATE SCHOOL ACCREDITED BY THE STATE BOARD DURING THE INDIVIDUAL'S JUNIOR OR SENIOR YEAR IN HIGH SCHOOL TO ENLIST IN THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES DURING WORLD WAR II.

(2)";

in lines 5 and 6, strike "JUNIOR OR"; strike line 7 in its entirety; and in lines 8 and 9, strike "(2)" and "(3)", respectively, and substitute "(1)" and "(2)", respectively.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, strike in their entirety lines 15 and 16 and substitute:

"SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has been passed by a yeay and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted."
