AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 390

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, after "Kittleman," insert "Klausmeier"; and strike beginning with "- Charles" in line 2 down through "Program" in line 3.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 15, after "Code;" insert "adding certain facilities to a list of facilities that the Department of Juvenile Services is authorized to establish and operate;"; and strike beginning with "requiring" in line 18 down through the first semicolon in line 29.

On page 2, in line 23, strike "2-118(f)," and substitute "2-117(a)".

On page 4, strike in their entirety lines 3 through 8, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 8, after line 25, insert:

"2-117.

(a) (1) The Department may establish and operate the facilities that are necessary to diagnose, care for, train, educate, and rehabilitate properly children who need these services.

(2) These facilities include:

(i) The Baltimore City Juvenile Justice Center;

(ii) The J. DeWeese Carter Center;

(Over)

- (iii) The Charles H. Hickey, Jr. School;
- (iv) The Alfred D. Noyes Children’s Center;

- (v) The Cheltenham Youth Facility;

- (vi) The Victor Cullen Center;

- (vii) The Thomas J. S. Waxter Children’s Center; [and]

- (viii) THE LOWER EASTERN SHORE CHILDREN’S CENTER;

- (IX) THE WESTERN MARYLAND CHILDREN’S CENTER; AND

- (X) The youth centers.”.

On pages 8 and 9, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 26 on page 8 through line 6 on page 9, inclusive.

On page 9, after line 6, insert:

“SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 83C - Juvenile Services”.

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 25, strike in their entirety lines 1 through 24, inclusive; and after line 24, insert:

“SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:”.

AMENDMENT NO. 5

On page 29, in line 11, strike “3.” and substitute “5.”.

On page 30, in lines 5, 11, and 31, strike “4.”, “5.” and “6.”, respectively, and substitute “6.”, “7.”, and “8.”, respectively.

On page 31, strike in their entirety lines 4 through 11, inclusive; and in lines 12, 19, 25, and
