AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 702, AS AMENDED

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1 of the House Judiciary Committee Amendments (HB0702/252717/1), in line 4 of Amendment No. 1, strike “medical necessity” and substitute “certain advice of a licensed physician”; and in lines 6 and 7, strike “medical necessity” and substitute “advice of a licensed physician”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2 of the House Judiciary Committee Amendments, in line 6 of Amendment No. 2, strike “OF MEDICAL NECESSITY” and substitute “THAT THE MARIJUANA WAS USED OR POSSESSED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ADVICE OF A LICENSED PHYSICIAN”; and in lines 8 and 9, strike “BECAUSE OF MEDICAL NECESSITY” and substitute “IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ADVICE OF A LICENSED PHYSICIAN”.

On page 3 of the House Judiciary Committee Amendments, in line 7 of Amendment No. 2, strike “OF MEDICAL NECESSITY” and substitute “THAT THE MARIJUANA WAS USED OR POSSESSED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ADVICE OF A LICENSED PHYSICIAN”; and in line 10, strike “BECAUSE OF MEDICAL NECESSITY” and substitute “IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ADVICE OF A LICENSED PHYSICIAN”.
