AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 122

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 3, strike “allowing a person to be debarred” and substitute “authorizing the debarment of a person”; strike beginning with “engaged” in line 4 down through the third “laws” in line 5 and substitute “been criminally convicted of, or found civilly liable for, a certain number of violations of certain laws”; and in line 6, after “to” insert “certain grounds for debarment from entering into”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike beginning with “ENGAGED” in line 31 down through “LAWS” in line 33 and substitute “BEEN CRIMINALLY CONVICTED OF, OR FOUND CIVILLY LIABLE FOR, AT LEAST TWO VIOLATIONS OF ANY FEDERAL OR MARYLAND:

(I) LABOR LAW, IF THE VIOLATIONS SIGNIFICANTLY IMPACT THE HEALTH OR SAFETY OF WORKERS;

(II) CIVIL RIGHTS LAW; OR

(III) ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION LAW, IF THE VIOLATIONS SIGNIFICANTLY IMPACT THE HEALTH OR SAFETY OF WORKERS OR MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC”.
