## AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 3, strike "allowing a person to be debarred" and substitute "<u>authorizing the debarment of a person</u>"; strike beginning with "engaged" in line 4 down through the third "laws" in line 5 and substitute "<u>been criminally convicted of</u>, or found civilly liable for, a certain number of <u>violations of certain laws</u>"; and in line 6, after "to" insert "<u>certain grounds for debarment from entering into</u>".

## AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike beginning with "ENGAGED" in line 31 down through "LAWS" in line 33 and substitute "<u>BEEN CRIMINALLY CONVICTED OF, OR FOUND CIVILLY LIABLE FOR, AT LEAST TWO VIOLATIONS OF ANY FEDERAL OR MARYLAND:</u>

(I) LABOR LAW, IF THE VIOLATIONS SIGNIFICANTLY IMPACT THE HEALTH OR SAFETY OF WORKERS;

## (II) <u>CIVIL RIGHTS LAW; OR</u>

(III) ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION LAW, IF THE VIOLATIONS SIGNIFICANTLY IMPACT THE HEALTH OR SAFETY OF WORKERS OR MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC".
