AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 233

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike beginning with “removing” in line 3 down through “the” in line 4 and substitute “authorizing a circuit court or the District Court to extend for certain periods a”; and in line 5, after “restitution;” insert “providing that a certain extension of probation may be unsupervised or supervised by the Division of Parole and Probation; altering the period beyond which a court may extend a defendant’s probation for the purpose of making restitution where the defendant consents to the extension in writing;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 20, after “but” insert “, SUBJECT TO SUBSECTIONS (B) AND (C) OF THIS SECTION,”; in line 24, after “(b)” insert “(1) ONLY FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAKING RESTITUTION, THE COURT MAY EXTEND THE PROBATION BEYOND THE TIME ALLOWED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION FOR:

(I) AN ADDITIONAL 5 YEARS IF THE PROBATION IS ORDERED BY A CIRCUIT COURT; OR

(II) AN ADDITIONAL 3 YEARS IF THE PROBATION IS ORDERED BY THE DISTRICT COURT.

(2) AN EXTENSION OF PROBATION UNDER THIS SUBSECTION MAY BE UNSUPERVISED OR SUPERVISED BY THE DIVISION OF PAROLE AND PROBATION.

(C)”;

in line 25, strike “(a)” and substitute “(B)”; and in the same line, strike the bracket.

On page 2, in line 2, strike the bracket.
