AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 733

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 4, after the second “of” insert “a circuit”; in line 5, strike “in” and substitute “kept by”; in lines 5 and 6, strike “of court’s office”; in line 6, strike “for” and substitute “to”; in lines 6 and 8, in each instance, after “persons” insert “or in accordance with a subpoena or court order”; and in lines 6 and 9, in each instance, after “of” insert “a circuit”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 8, strike “TO A PERSON”; in lines 9 and 16, in each instance, after “(I)” insert “TO”; in lines 9 and 16, in each instance, strike the first “CASE” and substitute “CIVIL, ADMINISTRATIVE, OR CRIMINAL PROCEEDING IN A FEDERAL OR STATE COURT OR GOVERNMENT AGENCY”; in lines 9 and 16, in each instance, strike “IN THE CASE”; in line 12, strike “A CASE” and substitute “THE PROCEEDING”; in lines 13 and 19, in each instance, after “(II)” insert “TO”; in line 15, strike “TO”; and in line 18, strike “CASE” and substitute “PROCEEDING”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, in lines 12 and 18, in each instance, strike “OR”; and in line 13, after “INTEREST” insert “;

(III) IN ACCORDANCE WITH A SUBPOENA OR COURT ORDER;

(IV) TO A SPOUSE, ADULT CHILD, PARENT, ADULT SIBLING, GRANDPARENT, OR GUARDIAN OF THE PERSON WHO IS THE SUBJECT OF THE DISCHARGE PAPERS; OR

(V) TO A RELATIVE OF THE PERSON WHO IS THE SUBJECT OF THE DISCHARGE PAPERS, IF THE REQUEST FOR INSPECTION IS MADE AT LEAST 70

On page 2, in line 19, after “INTEREST” insert “;

(III) IN ACCORDANCE WITH A SUBPOENA OR COURT ORDER;

(IV) TO A SPOUSE, ADULT CHILD, PARENT, ADULT SIBLING, GRANDPARENT, OR GUARDIAN OF THE PERSON WHO IS THE SUBJECT OF THE DISCHARGE PAPERS; OR

(V) TO A RELATIVE OF THE PERSON WHO IS THE SUBJECT OF THE DISCHARGE PAPERS, IF THE REQUEST FOR A CERTIFIED COPY IS MADE AT LEAST 70 YEARS AFTER THE DISCHARGE PAPERS WERE PRESENTED FOR RECORDING”.
