AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 193

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “and Harris” and substitute “, Harris, Forehand, Green, Haines, Jacobs, Jimeno, and Mooney”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, strike beginning with the first “for” in line 7 down through “speeds” in line 8, and substitute “in accordance with regulations adopted by the State Highway Administration consistent with certain standards or guidelines established by the Federal Highway Administration”; in line 10, after the semicolon insert “requiring the State Highway Administration to adopt certain regulations by a certain date;”; and in line 11, strike “minimum” and substitute “certain”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, in line 29, strike “FOR THE FOLLOWING MINIMUM TIME PERIODS:” and substitute “IN ACCORDANCE WITH REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE STATE HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION CONSISTENT WITH STANDARDS OR GUIDELINES ESTABLISHED BY THE FEDERAL HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION.”.

On pages 2 and 3, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 30 on page 2 through line 12 on page 3, inclusive.

On page 3, in lines 13 and 14, strike “TRAFFIC CONTROL AT AN INTERSECTION MONITORED BY”.

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 6, after line 36, insert:

“SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the State Highway Administration

(Over)

shall adopt regulations carrying out the provisions of § 21-202.1(b) of the Transportation Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland as provided in Section 1 of this Act by October 1, 2003.”;

and in line 37, strike “2.” and substitute “3.”.
