AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 544

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike “Tanning Room” and substitute “Private Place”; in line 3, strike “to a certain kind of room” and substitute “the definition of “private place”, for purposes of”; and in line 5, after the first “individual” insert “, to include a room where a person has a reasonable expectation of privacy for a certain purpose; exempting from the prohibition against visual surveillance a person who, without prurient intent, conducts otherwise lawful visual surveillance in a health care setting”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 19, after “(3)” insert “(I)”; strike beginning with “TANNING” in line 19 down through “room” in line 20 and substitute “ROOM, WHERE A PERSON HAS A REASONABLE EXPECTATION OF PRIVACY WHILE PARTIALLY OR FULLY DISROBED,”; and in lines 21, 22, and 23, strike “(i)”, “(ii)”, and “(iii)”, respectively, and substitute “1.”, “2.”, and “3.”, respectively.

On page 2, in lines 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 7, strike “(iv)”, “(v)”, “(vi)”, “(vii)”, “(viii)”, and “(ix)”, respectively, and substitute “4.”, “5.”, “6.”, “7.”, “8.”, and “9.”, respectively; and after line 7, insert:

“(II) “PRIVATE PLACE” INCLUDES A TANNING ROOM, DRESSING ROOM, BEDROOM, OR RESTROOM.”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, in line 19, strike the third “or”; and in line 23, after “occupation” insert “; OR

(4) CONDUCTS OTHERWISE LAWFUL VISUAL SURVEILLANCE IN A HEALTH CARE SETTING”.
