AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 564

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 17, after “terms;” insert “providing for the termination of this Act;”.

On page 2, after line 31, insert:

“(IV) ESTABLISH PROCEDURES FOR THE ORDERLY TRANSITION FROM AN EXISTING PRIVATE CONTRACTOR TO THE PRIVATE CONTRACTOR SELECTED TO CONTINUE PRIVATIZATION UNDER THIS SECTION;”;

and in line 32, strike “(IV)” and substitute “(V)”.

On page 3, in lines 6 and 9, strike “(V)” and “(VI)”, respectively, and substitute “(VI)” and “(VII)”, respectively; and in line 8, strike “(IV)” and substitute “(V)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 34, strike “FORMER” and substitute “EXISTING”.

On page 6, after line 35, insert:

“SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That a State employee who, on the effective date of this Act, is a nontemporary employee of the Child Support Enforcement Administration in the Department of Human Resources and is working for the private contractor under contract with the Department on the effective date of this Act, shall remain a nontemporary employee of the Administration until the termination of this Act, unless the employee accepts employment with another private contractor, as provided under § 10-119.1(d)(1)(v) of the Family Law Article, as enacted by Section 1 of this Act.”;

(Over)

and in line 36, strike “3.” and substitute “4.”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 5, in line 25, strike “TO THE ADMINISTRATION” and substitute “IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 10-115 OF THIS SUBTITLE”.

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 6, in line 34, strike “3 years” and substitute “4 years and 3 months”; in line 37, strike “5 years and 1 month” and substitute “6 years and 4 months”; and in line 38, strike “June 30, 2008” and substitute “September 30, 2009”.
