AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 804

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, after "Foundation -" insert "Guidelines for"; strike beginning with "Ranking" in line 2 down through "Valuation" in line 3 and substitute "Rankings"; strike beginning with "altering" in line 4 down through "value" in line 7 and substitute "including certain guidelines as required bases for a county governing body to rank certain easement applications; requiring the Foundation, in consultation with certain county governing bodies, to adopt certain guidelines that include consideration of certain factors"; strike beginning with ", and" in line 8 down through "easements" in line 9 and substitute "and easement rankings"; and in line 12, strike "and (f) and 2-511".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 12, strike "CAP"; strike beginning with ", CALCULATED" in line 12 down through "SUBTITLE" in line 13; in line 14, strike "ANY"; strike beginning with "TO" in line 14 down through "PROGRAM" in line 16 and substitute "UNDER PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION"; after line 16, insert:

"(3) (I) IN CONSULTATION WITH COUNTY GOVERNING BODIES, THE FOUNDATION SHALL ADOPT GUIDELINES TO IDENTIFY EASEMENTS FOR PURCHASE THAT FURTHER THE GOALS OF THE MARYLAND AGRICULTURAL LAND PRESERVATION PROGRAM.

(II) GUIDELINES ADOPTED UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL INCLUDE CONSIDERATION OF:

1. LOCATION IN A PRIORITY PRESERVATION AREA OF THE COUNTY;

(Over)

2. SOIL AND OTHER LAND CHARACTERISTICS ASSOCIATED WITH AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTIVITY;

3. AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTION AND CONTRIBUTION TO THE AGRICULTURAL ECONOMY; AND

4. ANY OTHER UNIQUE COUNTY CONSIDERATIONS THAT SUPPORT THE GOALS OF THE PROGRAM.”;

and in lines 17, 27, and 31, strike “(3)”, “(4)”, and “(5)”, respectively, and substitute “(4)”, “(5)”, and “(6)”, respectively.

On pages 2 through 5, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 34 on page 2 through line 6 on page 5, inclusive.
