#### AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in lines 15 and 16, strike "five thousand" and substitute "<u>more than 4,600</u>"; strike beginning with "unusually" in line 18 down through "communities" in line 19 and substitute "<u>higher</u> in some areas than in other areas"; in line 25, after "(b)" insert "<u>(1)</u>"; and in line 26, strike "(1)" and substitute "<u>(i)</u>".

On page 2, in lines 1, 3, 4, 6, 8, and 11, strike "(2)", "(3)", "(4)", "(5)", "(6)", and "(7)", respectively, and substitute "(ii)", "(iii)", "(iv)", "(v)", "(vi)", and "(vii)", respectively; in lines 12, 13, and 14, strike "(i)", "(ii)", and "(iii)", respectively, and substitute "<u>1</u>.", "<u>2</u>.", and "<u>3</u>.", respectively; in line 12, strike "representative of the copper plumbing industry" and substitute "<u>master plumber who is a resident of Maryland, is licensed by the State Board of Plumbing, and has expertise in the installation and replacement of copper plumbing"; in line 14, after "representatives" insert "from areas of the State served by different water suppliers"; and after line 14, insert:</u>

"(2) <u>The Task Force shall invite participation of a representative of the U.S.</u> <u>Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) with expertise in water chemistry, as designated by the</u> <u>EPA Administrator.</u>".

#### AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 23, after "(1)" insert "determine the extent, patterns, and trends of pinhole leaks in Maryland;

<u>(2)</u>";

in lines 24 and 25, strike beginning with "including" in line 24 down through "practices," in line 25 and substitute "<u>including</u>: water chemistry requirements adopted by the EPA; water treatment practices; water additives; copper plumbing design, manufacturing, and installation practices;"; in

lines 27 and 29, strike "(2)" and "(3)", respectively, and substitute "(3)" and "(4)", respectively; and in line 30, after "plumbing" insert "and possible steps for Maryland residents to take if they experience a problem with pinhole leaks".

# AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, in line 32, strike "2003" and substitute "2004".

On page 3, in line 2, strike "7" and substitute "<u>1 year and 8</u>"; and in line 3, strike "December 31, 2003" and substitute "<u>January 31, 2005</u>".
