AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 104

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 10, after “the” insert “licensing and regulation of”; in the same line, strike “outfitter” and substitute “outfitters”; and in line 11, strike “guide licenses;” and substitute “guides; providing for certain penalties;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 30, strike “\$500” and substitute “\$300”; and in line 31, strike “\$100” and substitute “\$50”.

On page 3, in line 1, strike “APPLICANTS” and substitute “AN APPLICANT”; in lines 2 and 3, in each instance, strike “INDIVIDUALS” and substitute “AN INDIVIDUAL”; in line 3, strike “IN THEIR CAPACITY”; strike beginning with “IF” in line 6 down through “(4)” in line 9; in line 10, strike “YEAR;” and substitute “YEAR.”; in line 11, strike “NO” and substitute “A”; in the same line, after “MAY” insert “NOT”; in line 12, after “LICENSE” insert a comma; in the same line, strike “HIS OWN BENEFIT” and substitute “THE USE AND BENEFIT OF AN INDIVIDUAL”; in line 13, strike “CORPORATION; AND” and substitute “CORPORATION.”; and in line 14, strike “SHALL” and substitute “MAY”.

On page 5, in line 11, after “LICENSE” insert “AND OTHER APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS”; strike beginning with “OTHER” in line 12 down through “(3)” in line 13 and substitute “PROCEDURES FOR”; in lines 14, 15, and 19, strike “(4)”, “(5)”, and “(7)”, respectively, and substitute “(3)”, “(4)”, and “(5)”, respectively; in line 14, strike the first “THE”; in line 16, after “GUIDES;” insert “AND”; strike in their entirety lines 17 and 18; in line 19, strike “REGULATIONS” and substitute “PROVISIONS”; and after line 20, insert:

“(I) (1) (I) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF THIS SECTION OR ANY REGULATION ADOPTED UNDER THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A

(Over)

MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000, REVOCATION OF THE INDIVIDUAL'S WATERFOWL OUTFITTER LICENSE OR WATERFOWL HUNTING GUIDE LICENSE, OR BOTH.

(II) EACH VIOLATION CONSTITUTES A SEPARATE OFFENSE.

(2) IF A WATERFOWL OUTFITTER LICENSE IS REVOKED, THE REVOCATION SHALL APPLY TO BOTH THE INDIVIDUAL AND ANY CORPORATION OR PARTNERSHIP THE INDIVIDUAL REPRESENTS.”.
