AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 25 (Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 6, after the semicolon insert "<u>requiring the Task Force to invite the</u> <u>participation of and solicit commentary from certain interested parties;</u>"; in the same line, strike "a"; in the same line, strike "report" and substitute "<u>reports</u>"; in line 7, strike "a"; and in the same line, strike "date" and substitute "<u>dates</u>".

On page 2, strike in their entirety lines 3 through 6, inclusive; in line 7, strike "(7)" and substitute "(5)"; strike in their entirety lines 13 through 15, inclusive, and substitute:

- "(i) <u>One representative of the commercial health insurance industry;</u>
- (ii) <u>One representative of a commercial health maintenance organization;</u>

<u>and</u>";

in line 17, strike "and"; and in line 18, strike "(8)" and substitute "(6)".

On page 2 and 3, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 27 on page 2 through line 10 on page 3, inclusive, and substitute:

"(v) One consumer member who is the family member of an adult who receives mental health care services;

(vi) One consumer member who is the family member of a child who receives mental health care services; and

(vii) One consumer member who receives mental health services; and

(Over)

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(7) One member representing the rural mental health community appointed by the Forvm for Rural Maryland.

(c) <u>The Task Force shall invite the participation of and solicit commentary from all</u> interested parties who are not members of the Task Force.".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, in lines 11, 13, 15, and 19, strike "(c)", "(d)", "(e)", and "(f)", respectively, and substitute "(d)", "(e)", "(f)", and "(g)", respectively; after line 28, insert:

"(2) <u>The systemic barriers experienced by commercially-insured individuals when</u> attempting to access community treatment;

(3) How to ensure that commercially-insured individuals have access to medically-necessary mental health treatment;";

in line 29, strike "(2)" and substitute "(4)"; in the same line, strike "differences" and substitute "difference"; in the same line, strike "the coverage of"; in the same line, after "services" insert "coverage provided by"; in the same line, strike "among"; in line 30, after the first "commercial" insert "health"; in line 32, strike "(3)" and substitute "(5)"; in the same line, after "the" insert "public and private"; in line 33, strike "system" and substitute "systems"; and in the same line, after the semicolon insert "and".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 4, strike lines 1 and 2 in their entirety; in line 3, strike "(5)" and substitute "(6)"; in the same line, after "<u>impact</u>" insert "<u>on the cost of health care coverage in the State</u>"; strike beginning with "<u>on</u>" in line 3 down through "<u>coverage</u>" in line 4 and substitute "<u>to the coverage or delivery of mental health care services</u>"; in line 5, strike "(g)" and substitute "<u>(h)</u>"; in the same line, strike "The Task Force shall report" and substitute "<u>On or before December 31, 2003, the Task Force shall issue a preliminary report of its findings, and on or before December 31, 2004, shall issue a final report of"; in line 7, strike ", on or before December 31,"; and in the same line, strike "<u>2004</u>".</u>
