AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 1075

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “Delegate Sophocleus” and substitute “Delegates Sophocleus, Benson, Boutin, Bromwell, Costa, Donoghue, Elliott, Goldwater, Hammen, Haynes, Hubbard, Kach, Mandel, McDonough, Morhaim, Murray, Nathan-Pulliam, Oaks, Pendergrass, Redmer, Rosenberg, Rudolph, Smigiel, V. Turner, and Weldon”; in line 2, strike “Exceptions” and substitute “Exemptions”; in line 6, strike “procurement”; in the same line, after “requirements” insert “of the procurement law”; strike beginning with “requiring” in line 6 down through “goals” in line 7 and substitute “providing that certain provisions of the minority business enterprise law apply to certain procurements by the Administration; requiring procurements by certain entities to promote certain purposes”; in line 8, strike “procurements by the Developmental Disabilities Administration” and substitute “exemptions from certain provisions of the procurement law”; and in line 11, after “11-203(a)” insert “and (b) (1) and (2)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, strike beginning with “SERVICES” in line 12 down through “ARTICLE” in line 15 and substitute “FAMILY AND INDIVIDUAL SUPPORT SERVICES, AND INDIVIDUAL FAMILY CARE SERVICES, AS THOSE TERMS ARE DEFINED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE IN REGULATION”; after line 27, insert:

“(b) (1) (I) The following provisions of this Division II apply to each procurement enumerated in subsection (a) of this section:

[i] 1. § 11-205 of this subtitle (“Fraud in procurement”);

[ii] 2. § 12-204 of this article (“Board approval for designated contracts”);

(Over)

[(iii)] 3. Title 12, Subtitle 2 of this article (“Supervision of Capital Expenditures and Real Property Leases”);

[(iv)] 4. § 13-219 of this article (“Required clauses - Nondiscrimination clause”);

[(v)] 5. § 13-221 of this article (“Disclosures to Secretary of State”);

[(vi)] 6. Title 16 of this article (“Debarment of Contractors”); and

[(vii)] 7. Title 17 of this article (“Special Provisions - State and Local Subdivisions”).

(II) TITLE 14, SUBTITLE 3 OF THIS ARTICLE APPLIES TO A PROCUREMENT BY THE MARYLAND DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES ADMINISTRATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE EXEMPT UNDER SUBSECTION (A)(1)(XVIII) OF THIS SECTION.

(2) A procurement by an entity listed in subsection (a)(1)(i) through [(xv)] (XVIII) of this section shall be made under procedures that promote the purposes stated in § 11-201(a) of this subtitle.”.
