AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 425

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike "Senator Della" and substitute "<u>Senators Della and Jones</u>"; strike line 5 in its entirety and substitute "<u>requiring the Authority to provide certain types of notice at certain times regarding the alteration of the boundary restrictions and a certain public hearing;"; and in line 11, strike "and (b)".</u>

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 14, strike the second set of brackets; in line 15, strike beginning with the comma through the second "Street"; and in line 21, strike "ON DOCK STREET".

On page 3, strike in their entirety lines 1 through 27, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3, after line 27, insert:

"SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

- (a) The Downtown Commercial District Management Authority within the City of Baltimore shall ensure that notice of the proposed alteration of the boundary restrictions under Section 1 of this Act is provided before any public hearing on the matter is conducted.
- (b) Notice of the date, time, and location of the hearing and the proposed boundary alterations shall be:
- (1) published prominently at least twice in a major newspaper of general circulation in Baltimore City, once approximately 1 month before the hearing and once approximately 2 weeks before the hearing;

- (2) included regularly in public service announcements carried on local radio and television stations, commencing approximately 1 month before the hearing; and
- (3) mailed by first-class postage at least 1 month before the hearing to at least 65% of the business and residential tenants located in the area to be affected under Section 1 of this Act.";

and in line 28, strike "2." and substitute "3.".
