AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 386

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike "and Zirkin" and substitute "Zirkin, Hurson, Boutin, Costa, Elliott, Goldwater, McDonough, Rudolph, Smigiel, and Weldon".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, strike beginning with "provide" in line 3 down through "C" in line 5 and substitute "review, recommend changes to, and solicit funds to implement a certain hepatitis C prevention plan"; and in line 10, after "terms;" insert "providing for the termination of this Act;".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, in lines 32 and 33, in each instance, strike "15" and substitute "16".

On page 3, in lines 11 and 12, in each instance, strike "TEN" and substitute "<u>ELEVEN</u>"; in line 23, strike "AND"; and in line 25, after "FOUNDATION" insert "; <u>AND</u>

(VIII) ONE SHALL BE A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE BALTIMORE CITY HEALTH DEPARTMENT".

On page 4, in line 11, strike "FOUR" and substitute "TWO".

On pages 4 and 5, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 14 on page 4 through line 26 on page 5, inclusive, and substitute:

"THE PURPOSE OF THE ADVISORY COUNCIL SHALL BE TO:

(1) REVIEW AND RECOMMEND CHANGES TO THE "MARYLAND HEPATITIS C PREVENTION AND CONTROL PLAN"; AND

(2) <u>SOLICIT ANY FUNDS OR GRANTS FROM ANY FEDERAL, LOCAL, PRIVATE, OR OTHER SOURCE TO IMPLEMENT "THE MARYLAND HEPATITIS C PREVENTION AND CONTROL PLAN"."</u>

in line 28, after "REPORT" insert "ON ITS ACTIVITIES AND RECOMMENDATIONS"; and strike beginning with the second "AND" in line 30 down through "SUBTITLE" in line 32.

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 6, in line 5, after "2003." insert "It shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and, at the end of September 30, 2005, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect."
