AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 56

(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, at the top of the page, strike “EMERGENCY BILL”; strike line 2 in its entirety and substitute:

“Education - High School Diploma - World War II, Korean Conflict, and Vietnam Conflict Veterans”;

and strike in their entirety lines 3 through 8, inclusive, and substitute:

“FOR the purpose of allowing an individual honorably discharged from military service to apply to certain county boards of education to obtain a high school diploma if the individual withdrew from a certain full-time public or private school under certain circumstances; requiring each county board of education to adopt certain rules and regulations; and generally relating to high school diplomas for certain veterans.”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 1 and 2, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 18 on page 1 down through line 2 on page 2, inclusive; in line 3, strike “(2)” and substitute “(A)”; in line 5, after “individual’s” insert “JUNIOR OR”; in line 6, after “during” insert “;”; and strike beginning with “[World” in line 6 down through “Conflict” in line 7 and substitute:

- “(1) WORLD WAR II;
- “(2) THE KOREAN CONFLICT; OR
- “(3) THE VIETNAM CONFLICT”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, strike beginning with “is” in line 13 down through “enacted” in line 17 and substitute “shall take effect October 1, 2003”.
