SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 466

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike lines 2 and 3 in their entirety and substitute "Juvenile Law - Prohibition Against Possession of Portable Pagers on School Property - Repeal".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, strike beginning with "establishing" in line 4 down through "counties" in line 11 and substitute "repealing a prohibition against the possession of portable pagers on public school property; and declaring the intent of the General Assembly"; and in line 12, strike "and reenacting, with amendments,".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On pages 1 through 3, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 20 on page 1 through line 3 on page 3, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 3, after line 3, insert:

"SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That it is the intent of the General Assembly that local education agencies, working with the State Department of Education, develop their own local policies regarding the use of portable pagers and cellular telephones on public school property and, in enacting Section 1 of this Act, it is not the intent of the General Assembly to encourage the use of portable pagers and cellular telephones on public school property during school hours."

and in line 4, strike "2." and substitute "3.".
