AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 888

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “and Wood” and substitute “Wood, Bates, Boutin, Cadden, Conroy, Frush, Healey, Hennessy, Howard, Kaiser, Minnick, Rudolph, Weldon, Hammen, Oaks, Murray, Costa, Benson, Mandel, McDonough, Redmer, Goldwater, Morhaim, Nathan-Pulliam, Elliott, Pendergrass, Bromwell, Haynes, Smigiel, Donoghue, and V. Turner”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 11, strike “a” and substitute “the Secretary’s”; in line 12, strike “and”; after line 12, insert:

- “(4) the Secretary of Transportation, or the Secretary’s designee;
- (5) the Secretary of the Environment, or the Secretary’s designee;
- (6) the President of the Southern Maryland Navy Alliance;
- (7) the President of the Army Alliance;
- (8) the President of the Naval Energetics Alliance;
- (9) the President of the Maritime Alliance;
- (10) the President of the Fort Detrick Alliance; and”;

in line 13, strike “(4)” and substitute “(11)”; in the same line strike “six” and substitute “five”; strike beginning with “of” in line 13 down through “citizens” in line 14; strike line 15 in its entirety; in line 16, strike “(d)” and substitute “(c)(1)”; after line 16, insert:

(Over)

“(2) The chairman may:

(i) appoint additional members who are presidents of other military base advocacy groups that are nonprofit organizations and recognized by the Department of Business and Economic Development; and

(ii) appoint ex officio members as necessary to address specific issues, including a representative of the Maryland National Guard.”;

in lines 17, 19, and 22, strike “(e)”, “(f)”, and “(g)”, respectively, and substitute “(d)”, “(e)”, and “(f)”, respectively; and in line 32, after “State,” insert “academic institutions.”.

On page 3, in line 6, strike “(h)” and substitute “(g)”.
