## AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL NO. 588 (First Reading File Bill)

On page 1, in line 3, after "Membership" insert "<u>and Scope of Authority</u>"; in line 4, after the first "of" insert "<u>specifying that provisions of law regulating audiologists, hearing aid dispensers, and speech-language pathologists do not limit the right of a physician to dispense hearing aids;</u>"; in line 6, after "composition" insert "<u>and scope of authority</u>"; in line 10, after "Section" insert "<u>2-102 and</u>"; and after line 15, insert:

"<u>2-102.</u>

This title does not:

(1) Limit the right of an individual to practice a health occupation that the individual is authorized to practice under this article;

(2) Prohibit an individual from practicing any other profession that the individual is authorized to practice under the laws of this State; or

(3) Limit the right of a physician who is authorized to practice medicine under the laws of the State to treat the human ear or TO fit OR TO DISPENSE hearing aids.".
