### AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 879

(First Reading File Bill)

### AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, after the second "State" insert "Officers, Employees, and"; in line 4, strike "requiring" and substitute "authorizing"; in line 5, strike "law enforcement"; in the same line, after "officers" insert "and State employees"; strike beginning with "back" in line 5 down through "fees" in line 6 and substitute "wages"; in line 8, after "officer" insert "or employee"; in line 11, after "circumstances;" insert "requiring the Board of Public Works to approve payment of lost wages and reasonable attorneys' fees resulting from a certain suspension without pay to an applicant from a State law enforcement agency under certain circumstances; prohibiting the Board from approving certain payments under certain circumstances; providing for the application of this Act;"; and in line 12, after "State" insert "officer, employee, or".

#### AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 12, strike the brackets; and in the same line, strike "SHALL".

## AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3, in line 19, strike "THE" and substitute "(A) SUBJECT TO THE LIMITATIONS OF SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, THE"; in line 22, strike "PAY" and substitute "WAGES"; and after line 27, insert:

- "(B) THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS MAY NOT APPROVE PAYMENT UNDER THIS SECTION IF:
- (1) THE APPLICANT IS TERMINATED FROM EMPLOYMENT WITH THE STATE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY AS A RESULT OF AN ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDING RESULTING FROM THE SAME CRIMINAL CHARGES; OR
- (2) THE APPLICANT RESIGNS FROM THE APPLICANT'S POSITION WITH THE STATE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY BEFORE RESUMING DUTIES FOR PAY.".
