AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 369 (Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike "Against a" and substitute "<u>on</u>"; in the same line, strike "-Penalties"; strike beginning with "establishing" in line 3 down through "<u>duties</u>" in line 8 and substitute "<u>making it a felony to commit an assault that causes physical injury to certain law</u> <u>enforcement officers under certain circumstances</u>"; in line 13, strike "<u>against certain</u>" and substitute "<u>on a</u>"; in the same line, strike "<u>officers</u>" and substitute "<u>officer</u>"; strike beginning with "establishing" in line 13 down through "term;" in line 14; in line 14, after "to" insert "<u>the crime of</u>"; strike beginning with "against" in line 14 down through "officers" in line 15; and in line 18, strike "<u>3-201, 3-202, and</u>".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 2 and 3, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 17 on page 2 through line 10 on page 3, inclusive.

On page 3, in lines 13 and 14, strike beginning with "(b)" in line 13 down through "<u>SECTION</u>," in line 14 and substitute:

"(B) (1) IN THIS SUBSECTION, "PHYSICAL INJURY" DOES NOT INCLUDE MINOR, TEMPORARY INJURIES.

(2) <u>A PERSON MAY NOT COMMIT AN ASSAULT THAT CAUSES</u> <u>PHYSICAL INJURY TO ANOTHER PERSON KNOWING OR HAVING REASON TO KNOW</u> <u>THAT THE OTHER PERSON IS PERFORMING OFFICIAL DUTIES AS:</u>

(I) <u>A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER AS DEFINED IN § 3-101(E)</u> OF THE PUBLIC SAFETY ARTICLE; OR

(II) <u>AN OFFICER SERVING IN A PROBATIONARY STATUS.</u> (C)";

and strike in their entirety lines 17 through 24, inclusive, and substitute:

"(D) <u>A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION IS GUILTY</u> OF THE FELONY OF ASSAULT ON A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER IN THE SECOND DEGREE AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 10 YEARS OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$2,500 OR BOTH.".

On page 4, in line 23, strike "(<u>C</u>)" and substitute "(<u>B</u>)".
